

World chemicals sales (2023; €5,195 bn)





Global market share of Europe more than halved in 20 years







Domestic market share:


Chemicals made in Europe losing share in the domestic EU27 market over the past years (from 82% in 2003 to 70% in 2023)

Import intensity: 30% of EU27 chemicals consumption is attributable to non-EU27 imports, far above the 18% generated in 2003.






In a recovering global market, the European chemical production declines sharply




This crisis is unprecedented in terms of length

Illustrative evolution of utilization rate in recent crisis Base 2008-2011, 2020-2021, 2021-aujourd'hui


